

<p><b>RNase Activity (Extended Digestion)</b>            A 10 µl reaction in NEBuffer 4 containing 40 ng of a 300 base single-stranded RNA and a minimum of 1 µl of Klenow Fragment (3'–5' exo-) is incubated at 37°C. After incubation for 16 hours, &gt;90% of the substrate RNA remains intact as determined by gel electrophoresis using fluorescence detection.</p>	Pass
<p><b>Single Stranded DNase Activity (FAM-Labeled Oligo)</b>            A 50 µl reaction in NEBuffer 2 containing a 10 nM solution of a fluorescent internal labeled oligonucleotide and a minimum of 50 units of Klenow Fragment (3'–5' exo-) incubated for 30 minutes at 37°C yields &lt;10% degradation as determined by fluorescent detection.</p>	Pass
